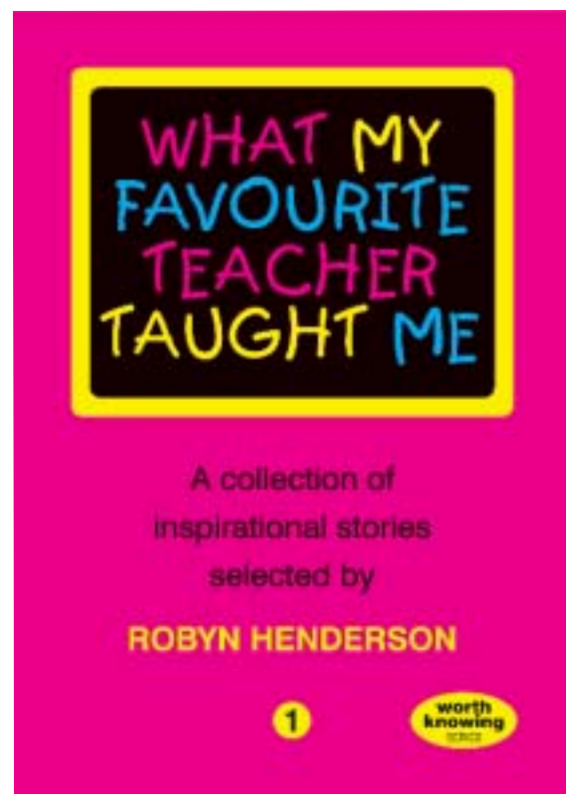
Let's remember and celebrate those people who have made an impact on our lives. This book does just that.
